



Installing driver for KWC-100 in Vista:


- 1.- Uncompress the zip file in the local drive of your system.
- 2.- Plug the webcam to the system USB port.
- 3.- Once the system finds the new hardware, click on “Locate and install driver software (recommended)”.




- 4.- Click on “I don't have a disc. Show me other options”.



5.- Click on “Browse my computer for driver software (advance)”.




6.- Click on the browse button and search for the uncompress zip file directory (e.g. C:\KWC-100 Vista). Click Next.



7.- On the Windows Security window click on “Install this driver software anyway”




8.- Click on Close once the driver has been installed successfully.




Upgrading the driver for KWC-100 in Vista:


- 1.- Uncompress the zip file in the local drive of your system.
- 2.- Open Device Manager and right click on the USB camera device with the exclamation yellow mark. Select update driver.




- 3.- Click on "Browse my computer for driver software"
